

# Versteeg applies for livestock feedlot permit

Notice is hereby given per Minnesota Statutes 116.07, subd. 7(a), that Harold Versteeg will be applying to Rock County and the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency for a permit to expand a feedlot with a capacity of 500 animal units or more.

The feedlot proposed to be expanded is located in the NW 1/4 of Section 32 of Battle Plain Township, T104N, R44W, of Rock County, Minnesota. The existing feedlot currently has 2,000 head of grow-to-finish swine housed in two total confinement buildings for a total of 600 animal units. The proposed expansion will consist of one total confinement building and an additional 2,800 head of grow-to-finish swine for a total of 4,800 head of grow-to-finish swine on site. All manure will be stored in under-floor concrete pits. After the expansion the feedlot will consist of 1,140 animal units. The feedlot will be owned by Harold Versteeg.

This publication shall constitute as notice to each resident and each owner of real property within 5,000 feet of the perimeter of the expanding feedlot as required by Minnesota State Law.
